250th Anniversary of the Hymn: Amazing Grace

On 1 Jan 1773, an amazing hymn was composed and so this month we mark the 250th anniversary of this hymn Amazing Grace composed by John Newton.



I remember singing this hymn at Toa Payoh Methodist Church in the1970s at the MYF. I was playing the guitar then as a young secondary school boy brought by Sharon, my second sister and it ministered to my heart.

Visit to Newton's Church



In May 2017, we led the Puritans (England) & Covenanters (Scotland)

Reformation Tour. As part of the itinerary, we visited at Olney the St Paul and St Peter Anglican church when John Newton was the Curate for many years in Buckinghamshire, and the nearby museum as well. It was here that the song was popularized as he and William Cowper (the famous composer who wrote God Moves in a Mysterious Way and was depressed and almost suicidal once) composed the Olney hymns in 1779. Later by the



will of God, it went viral and travelled all over the world. Even Billy Graham used it in his crusades and it was also sung at America Got Talent and even in the White House and many concerts and singing contests too.

History and Background

Rev John Newton (1725-1807) was a slave trader making good money when the Lord convicted his heart of sin during a stormy ride on the treacherous sea in March 1748 which he feared. **He was thoroughly converted, and it changed the direction of his life, and he served the Lord and is a godly man of much prayers**.

Chris Armstrong recalled

"At first Newton was convinced that he had sinned too much to have any hope for God's forgiveness. Yet when the storm did not recede

and he really felt he would soon meet his God, he at last clung to Scriptures that taught God's grace towards sinners, and he breathed his first weak prayer in years. As he was later to recall it, this was "the hour he first believed."


That is why you have in one of the stanzas,

Through many dangers, toils and snares, I have already come,

Tis Grace have brought me safe thus far, And Grace will lead me home.

There were many other hymns that John composed but nothing beats the heart felt poignant words of this global Christian hymn that has convicted and comforted sinners and saints for 250 years.

John was a good friend of William Wilberforce and encouraged him to abolish the slave trade that he was involved in some years ago and it was finally abolished in 1772 by the sovereign will of God.



Ending Well in Life

Chris Armstrong wrote,

"Over the fireplace in his vicarage study at Olney, where he would always see it as he prepared for Sunday services and mid-week meetings, he placed a plaque reading, in large letters, as follows:

"Since thou wast precious in my sight,



thou hast been honourable (Isa. 18:4), BUT Thou shalt remember that thou wast a bondman in the land of Egypt, and the Lord thy God redeemed thee (Deut. 15:15)."



redemption:

We have a good example for us to emulate that we may hopefully end well too in our lives one day as the Lord leads.

Take sometime today in your quiet moments and meditate on the lyrics of this hymn again and maybe someone need to hear it and be saved or even revive and come back to the Lord for those who may have backslided and need to return to Christ in faith and repentance.

Only eternity can tell how many souls were saved by these lifegiving lyrics of this hymn through the Holy Spirit.

When he died, Newton left behind the epitaph that remains today on his gravestone. It returns to this same twin theme of slavery from sin and unmerited

"John Newton, clerk, once an infidel and libertine, a servant of slaves in Africa, was, by the rich mercy of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, preserved, restored, pardoned, and appointed to preach the faith he had long laboured to destroy."

It is sometimes even more powerful than a sermon and has the transforming power in awakening hearts when placed in the hand of a gracious and holy God.



In life, I also thank Pastor, Angie and all the brothers and sisters for holding us up with prayers and supporting us through love, especially your love, acceptance, and prayers for my son Jireh.

In the process of life, there are joys and sorrows, and sickness of the mind and body. Every time it comes, it will bring us pain and sorrow. Proverbs 17:22 says: A merry heart doeth good like a medicine, *but a broken spirit drieth the bones*. This verse changed my heart, suffering is a blessing in disguise. I understood it turned out that we suffered all these things, and God wanted me to learn lessons through suffering, to get better blessings. Thinking of this, always found the lost joy in my life. In a Hokkien song, my favourite is "祂不放弃我"(The Lord will never leave me), and I often sing it repeatedly.

On Monday, I made three phone calls. These three people were suffering, one had unbelieving husband who is unfaithful, one sister in Christ had cancer, and other one was my elder brother. He

In Psalm 28:7, "The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped; therefore, my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song will I praise him." In the process of life experience, this scripture often encourages me. So, I can comfort their weak hearts with the love of God.

Our children live in rebellion and unhappiness. What a sad, painful, and heavy burden for Joseph and me. Whenever we are extremely helpless, God's words come to my mind again, "Isaiah 55:8-9 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than Your thoughts", Psalm 103:11 "For as the heavens is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him."
