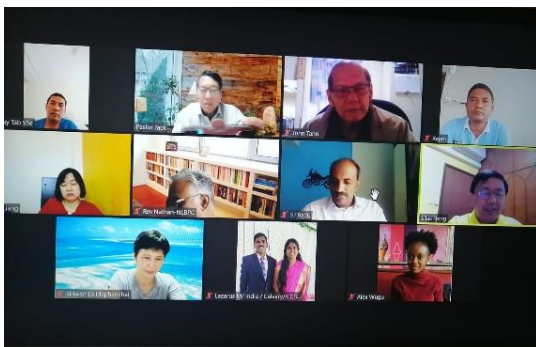
We are exhorted to be:

2. **Positive** and constructive in our outlook too and not be complaining or murmuring or spreading rumours, while being careful and disciplined, waiting and trusting in the Lord for his divine guidance and protection and doing our part too.
3. **Productive** or diligent and not indolent, in our studies of the Word, in our secular work or studies or home making. We are to do what we can within our means to help others for the Lord while waiting upon Him and not being idle. The holidays have started. Let all students be industrious to do your homework and attend all virtual classes.
4. **Praying** fervently for divine intervention in the revival and safety of our family, church and for wisdom for the leaders of our nation and for the spiritual and physical wellbeing of health care workers and our seniors and children and others affected while working and waiting on the Lord.
5. **Persevering and Persistent** in our gospel witness, missions, ministry and sabbath worship of the Lord as well. Do not give up easily in the midst of this calamity as we humbly seek the Lord.

 our fellowship, helpful*

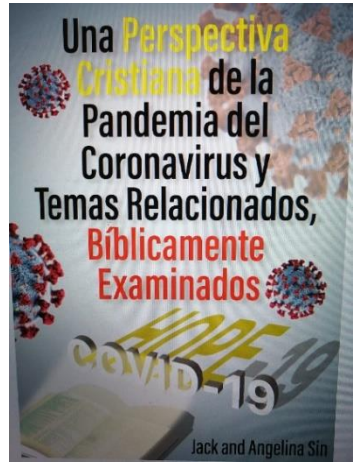
and let us be dutiful in our responsibility to God and to one another.

We put the Spanish pandemic book on Facebook and sent out letters via email to the Christian Bookstores and other groups by WhatsApp. We were encouraged when we visited the bookstores and got our first order of 50 copies and one lady from Facebook ordered another 50. We sold some in our church at discounted prices and some in our bookstore. We had a little discouragement when we visited two bookstores and learned that the director of the Baptist bookstore had died and the lady in charge was on vacation.



At another bookstore the lady in charge, was not there also, so we have to visit or by email or telephone contact them again. We visited the television station bookstore and sent a book to the president of the station who said he would read the book and let us know; we gave the television station bookstore lady the book to read also. We gave out about 40 free books all told.

I trust we can get some of the books to our mission headquarters and anybody going to Chile or Peru can take some down and pay later, when they sell them. There are other possibilities and we will let you know them in the future. Pray for us and our secretary; her name is Zulma Bor.

An Interest in the Blood Moon?



On 27 May 2021, we could see the blood moon over Singapore and it generated some interest in eschatology among some who were curious if it could mean anything related to the second coming of Christ.

A popular teaching in the past couple of years was that a series of blood-red moons which appeared in 2014 and 2015 could be a sign of Jesus' second coming and a fulfilment of biblical prophecy.

A lunar eclipse is often referred to as a "blood moon" and some prophets so called predicted that this series of blood moons would fulfil end-time prophecies in Joel and Revelation.

We have to be very disciplined, discerning, and careful here in the proper understanding and interpreting of scripture, that we do not misread or misinterpret the text to suit our emotional or psychological inclinations.

In both 2014 and 2015, there was a full lunar eclipse. In addition to the two lunar eclipses of 2015, two solar eclipses also occurred in time past, which is unusual but not unprecedented.

References to a moon like "blood" are found in two passages of the Bible. Joel 2:30-31 says, "I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and billows of smoke. The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord." (see also Lk 21:25,26)

In Rev 6:12, John describes one of the seal judgments of the Tribulation: "I watched as he opened the sixth seal. There was a great earthquake. The sun turned black like sackcloth made of goat hair, the whole moon turned blood red." Other passages refer to the moon being "darkened and there is no light in the context of the Tribulation (Matt 24:29; Joel 2:10).

A number of lunar eclipses have occurred over the decades and centuries. So, the fact of the occurrence of lunar eclipses, is no proof that Jesus would return by 2015 or any certain date as predicted by some.

Furthermore, John's and Joel's descriptions of the signs of the Day of the Lord may or may not just refer to just solar and lunar eclipses, but there are other possible cosmological explanations for those

phenomena (see Rev 6:12 where an earthquake accompanies it and the sun and moon are affected).

Are we now in the midst of the 7-year Great Tribulation and is the Antichrist clearly evident at this moment? Are the Seal judgements in place and the Trumpet and Bowl judgments in already? (Some quarters even propounded that the vaccination is the sure sign of the mark of the Beast, the 666.)

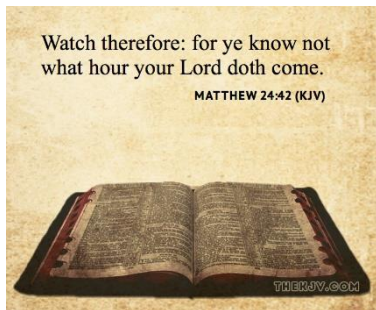
Absolutely no, as there are this and other prophecies that are yet to be fulfilled and they are spoken in the context of the Great Tribulation which is impending In the near future but not yet evident In the world as at now.

There is much excitement among the Christian community over end time prophecy as we live in perilous times with this pandemic and we can understand why, but beware of potential soothsayers and so-called prophets who make unsound and unbiblical predictions to cause undue alarm based on defective interpretation of the bible.

We believe in the imminence of the coming of Christ that requires patience, intelligent waiting and industrious witnessing and working for Christ in the gospel, but we will not go beyond what is not stated in scriptures which is at best speculative, if not misleading by some overly zealous teachers (2 Pet 3:9-14). We need to be prudently watching what happens to Israel and the Middle East and the ecumenical scene worldwide, the ecclesiastical, political, economic climate and other extraordinary physical calamities are relevant too, not only a global pestilence which is significant. (Matt 24:5-14)

Anyone who tries to give you a date or dates of Christ's second coming, beware, no matter who he or she is, for we are already forewarned that no one knows the hour of His coming (Matt 24:42).

Hope this helps for a sound and faithful, patient and diligent waiting, serving and worshipping, labouring for the Lord with readiness - hopefully without the deceptive even conjectures of men.

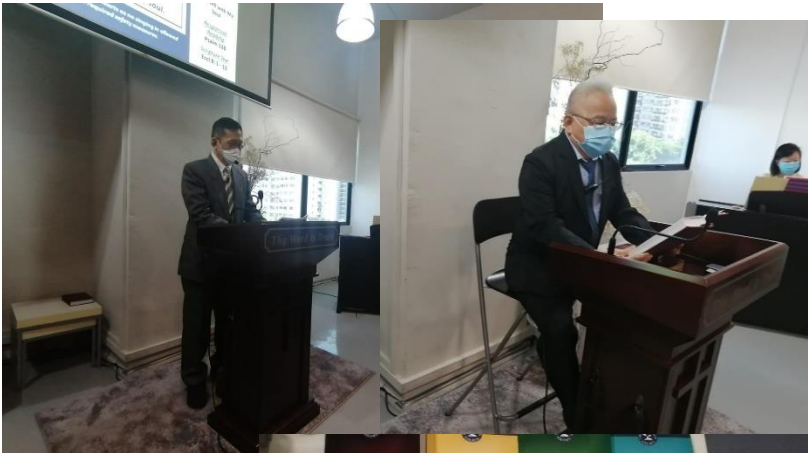
Once again, I want to thank you & the brother for the cash. The food supply will take us through for some days.

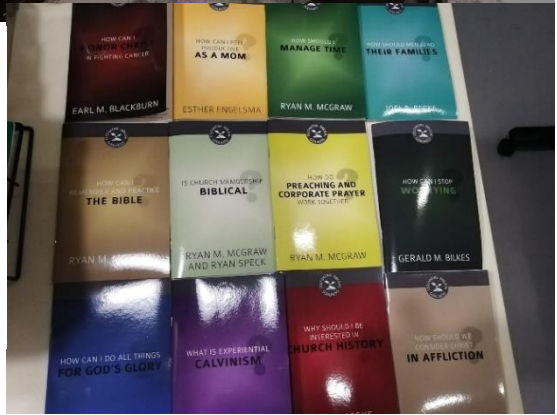
