With a united spirit in fervent evangelism, missions and outreach, the initial congregation has grown to what it is today including the evening Chinese service and missions, and we are still growing by the covenant mercies of God. It is our prayerful desire to have our own worship premise by the will of God and today's offering is designated for this purpose.

This church had been used of the Lord and by His grace to minister to many in the vicinity and even to the Chinese brethren here in Singapore and abroad including those in country x.

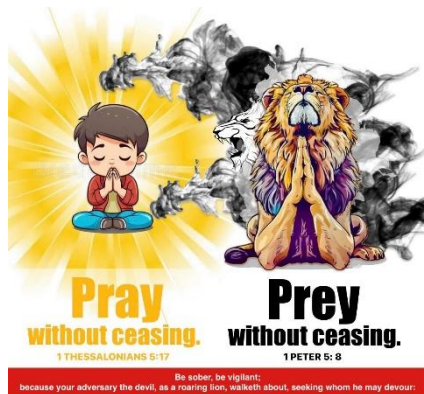

Our church will continue to have the following important focus in the acrostic, P-O-S-B in the days ahead. They are:

Prayers - Both Corporate & Personal

Prayer is the breath of godliness and a great privilege given to redeemed souls. The apostles were committed to fervent intercession for the flock (Acts 1:14, 24). This is so important that nothing should displace it, especially our corporate Wednesday night Prayer Meeting where about 15 from the church and associated missions meet to pray for one another. **A prayerless church is a powerless church and so we must remember to go on our knees humbly to beseech the Lord to lead and guide and prosper the church as a united people.** We are exhorted to pray continually and with fervency too. John 16:24 says, *'Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.'* Let us remember to seek the Lord on our knees as a church for the spiritual wellbeing of our families and friends in the revival of souls as the Lord leads. King Solomon says in 2 Chr 7:14 says, *'If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.'*



Outreach in Christ-centred Missions & Responsible Discipleship

We live in a Fallen world where men and women need the gospel to be saved and delivered from the wrath of God and the **bondage of sin by the vicarious atonement of Christ** (Rom 3:24-25). We are to seek Christ as our Lord, taking up the Cross and following Him. **The teaching of Scripture is the abiding rule of faith and in personal and corporate holiness and to be separate from the world of sin.**

We have our evangelism in the Macpherson estate, and many have received our tracts and Gideon Bibles, and some have come to our church. In Apr 2020 during the pandemic, we started an online Chinese Fellowship meeting on every Sunday night to reach out to both locally and Malaysia and in country x. As we searched the Word, we grow in the faith together. We are also

associated with the growing congregation in New Covenant BP Church pastored by Pastor Babu in Varthur village with about 60 people. They had their sanctuary renovated and completed last month. A mission team led by Eld Yue Kay represented us and ministered at their 25th Anniversary Thanksgiving Service and also conducted an outreach to the KinderBees Preschool. God use us as weak instruments to support our BP missions and churches as we also ministered at Filadelfia BP Church (Batam) led by Ev Ang Liang last year at a special service and to their children home.

Last month, a mission team led by Dr Samuel Gan taught at the MA course in Myanmar Theological Seminary led by Rev David Khobal. (Pastor has been an adjunct lecturer of MTS for more than 6 years.) The team also ministered at the Gilead Balm Home led by Eld Habbukuk. **There is much to be done for the cause of Christ in these remaining last days and let us be united in these spiritual endeavours together in the Lord to propagate the glorious gift of everlasting life.** Each week, our recorded Sunday sermons on the church website are accessed by about 140 people and the weeklies are being read by about 80 people. Let us pray that the Word will edify and exhort their hearts towards Christ.

Sharing in Fellowship, Stewardship & God Honouring Worship

The reverential worship of our thrice holy God is practiced in this church in the beauty of holiness and also in “spirit and in truth” (Jn 4:22-24) and in orderliness and decency. The WCF teaches us the



regulative principle that governs Sabbath worship and we adhere to it. The worship is theocentric, and not anthropocentric, and all true worshippers must have a spirit of reverence for God worship in discerning and orderly manner, with love for the Lord as a congregation. We pray that all will honour the Lord on Sunday and keep the Christian sabbath day holy as the 4th commandment requires us.

We also thank God for the faithful and sacrificial stewards in our church serving in the various Sun school classes, evangelism, fellowship and care ministries, church choir and music ministry, resource library, audio visual, refreshments, cleaning and upkeep, and Session leaders and others. We need more members to reach out to church members and their families and friends. We encourage all to come for the coming church camp in June in Batam. Recently many of our members visited and reached out to our late Bro Micheal in the hospital and attended the funeral service. Let us continue to support, strengthen and comfort the flock through the trying circumstances of life.

The local church is the powerhouse of God for the cause of the gospel. The New Testament apostles emphasise **commitment to God through the local church with the conversion and nurture of souls** (Acts 2:39-40). We believe in the covenant family who is set apart for God. Baptized believers should unite as a church family to continue to worship and serve God the Lord and have regular family worship. We pray that our members are responsible stewards with our gifts and talents and giving, with the pastoral care led by the elders. Our community outreach ministry includes the All Saints Home BS ministry to the residents. Let us press on with intercessory prayer for one another both privately and at our weekly Wednesday night Prayer Meetings, the preaching of the Word, biblical counselling for our worshippers rooted in the doctrines of grace.

Bible Preaching & Teaching of the Sufficient Word of God

The apostolic tradition and the 16th century Protestant Reformation and its Reformed doctrines are grounded in the authority, inspiration, inerrancy, and sufficiency of the Bible in all matters of faith and practice, justification by faith and the universal priesthood of believers. Preaching from the Word



of God in our church and to other churches and missions to convict, exhort saints and convert and correct sinners is the core business of the church in the service of God. **The inerrant Word is important to be declared in a relevant and understandable manner with the right explanation, interpretations and applications.** We should also address the spiritual needs and pray for the awakening of hearts of the congregation and the saving of souls as God wills.



We will continue to declare the glorious message of everlasting life to save souls and to nurture the flock in the word of God from the pulpit, at church camps, seminars and SS school class and at prayer meetings. This is a most vital part of

true Reformed worship. The Word of God is unashamedly preached every Lord's Day from this church pulpit to the conviction of hearts. **The clear declaration and exposition of the bible is central to the vitality and health of the church.** Priority

is given to the preparation and the faithful proclamation and expository teaching of the Gospel and the Word.

Teaching sound doctrine and defending the faith are needful as we must be grounded and rooted in the doctrines through the proper instruction from the pulpit, the SS classes and at the prayer meetings. We are to be ready to give an answer for our faith when asked (1Pet 3:15). 1Thes 2:13 says, *'For this cause*

also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.'

As a Reformed church, we recognise that our God is Omnipotent. Omnipresent and Omniscient. He has also chosen some unconditionally by His sovereign good pleasure before the creation of the world to be redeemed by His substitutionary atoning death on the cross (Eph 1:4; Mt 1:21). We are but unworthy creatures chosen to be beneficiaries of the manifold grace of God with the partaking of two sacraments. The sacrament of the Lord's Supper is served every second Sunday in remembrance of Christ's death. We thank God for the baptism of our octogenarian Mr Low last month at the Christmas Eve service and today we will baptize Chandler Zeng according to the Word of God after a proper study of the shorter catechism (Acts 2:38-39). His testimony of salvation is shared in this church weekly as we witness the power of the Gospel to redeem souls.

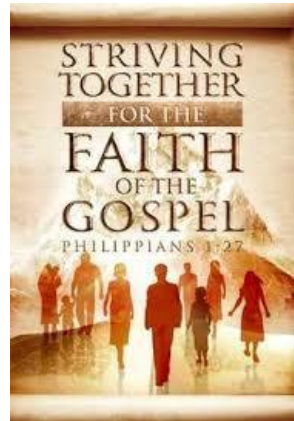
Conclusion

Testimony of Chandler Zeng

Before these experiences, I did not truly believe in God. I relied on logic, planning, and my own ability to solve problems. When difficulties came, I depended entirely on myself.



That changed when my cat escaped from home. On the same day, the tracking device also failed, leaving me unable to search for him. I looked online for advice and read that if a lost cat is not found within three days, it may never return. I felt helpless and anxious, facing a situation completely beyond my control. Around that time, I remembered what I had learned from Samuel's CMI course. Although I was not a believer, I decided to pray. Not out of habit, but out of desperation. I prayed simply and honestly, asking God for help, even though I was unsure if He was listening. The first three days passed with no sign of my cat. I felt disappointed and began to doubt, but I continued to pray. On the fourth day, my cat returned home by himself. There was no human explanation. In that moment, something changed in my heart. I realized that what I had experienced was more than a coincidence. For the first time, I sensed that God was real, attentive, and at work even when I could not see it.

The second experience happened to me personally during a trip to Malaysia, when I lost my phone. The phone was lost during travel, far from home, and I believed it was gone forever. I tried to track it, but all attempts failed. From a logical perspective, there was no reason to hope for its return. After I had already left Malaysia and returned to China, something completely unexpected happened. My phone was found in a shopping mall near my university, thousands of kilometers away from where it was lost. Despite crossing borders and passing through unknown hands, it was eventually returned to me safely. There was no reasonable explanation for how this could have happened. This experience deeply impacted me. I began to understand that God is not limited by distance, time, or circumstance. Even when something seems permanently lost, God is able to restore it in His own way.

These experiences marked a turning point in my life. I began to pray every day, not just when I was in trouble, but as a way to seek truth and guidance. I started attending church regularly, where I learned about the gospel and came to understand who Jesus Christ is. I came to understand that Jesus died for my sins and rose again, offering forgiveness, new life, and salvation by grace. I repented of self-dependence and chose to place my trust in Jesus Christ as my savior. My life has changed since then. I no longer walk alone or rely only on myself. God used these simple yet powerful experiences to lead me from non-belief to faith, from self-reliance to trust in Him, and from being lost to being saved.

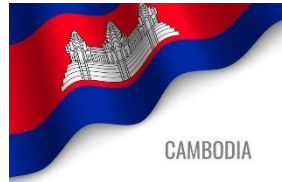

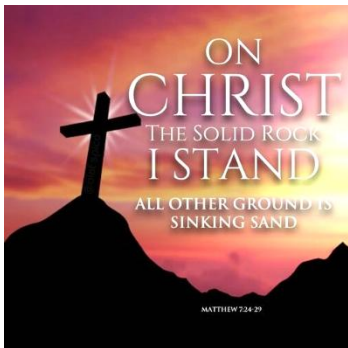
