Biblical Purpose of Church Membership

Is church membership really necessary? Can't a Christian worship or have fellowship with a particular congregation while still remaining a "perpetual visitor"?



That is a good question. To answer this, we first need to understand what the true church is. The universal church or Body of Christ (Romans 12:5) is composed only and entirely of elect and true believers in Christ. Non-believers are not part of that Body although they may attend the Sunday service and we pray for their salvation. During the time of the early church, 'the Lord added to



them daily such as should be saved' (Acts 2:47). This verse indicates that salvation is the pre-requisite for being 'added' to the local church. Reformed churches that require evidence of salvation (or baptism for some and the shorter catechism class to be attended) before the acceptance of membership which is the needful, responsible and proper thing to do.

Mal 3:16 says: 'Then they that feared the Lord spake often to one another: and the Lord

hearkened and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the Lord, and that thought upon his name'. Similarly, we infer such a list from Revelation 20:12 with its focus on the Lamb's book of life. So, if the Lord has a 'membership roll' in heaven for the elect, it is surely right for local churches to establish and maintain a list of its true members on earth, to the best of its ability.

Identification with Christ and His Covenant People Membership and accountability to a local church are also strongly implied in Paul's instructions in 1 Cor 5:12. The verse speaks of those 'without' and 'within' the church. All

such language is meaningless without a clearly defined group and local community of members who are accountable to God within that community.

Why is Church Membership Important? It is firstly a way of publicly identifying yourself with a local group of Christians who worships and serves the Lord together. It is a statement that you are in agreement with their doctrines and practices and that you are a legitimate representative of it, accountable to God and to the church. While we believe in the universal church, it is also important to belong to the visible church where you are In the New Testament, there were churches in Corinth, Philippi, Galatia, Ephesus and so on. They were local churches with local membership comprising a local resident Pastor, Elders and Deacons to take care of the church members which is the biblical model.

Church membership determines in a rightful manner who is permitted to play a role/part in the life of the church ministry and be involved in her gospel work. Members have a vital part to play in a church's life, growth, direction and the mutual edification of the flock and even missions and outreaches. They have to profess in their membership initiation that they adhere to the biblical standards, the doctrinal stand and the constitution of that local church publicly.

Membership is, in effect, a way of saying, "I believe in God, and I am not ashamed to be a Christian; and, to demonstrate that, I identify with this particular church where Christ is the head."

So, it is natural and biblical to consider joining the church membership of a Bible-believing church after attending it for a suitable time and finding that you have been ministered by the preaching of the Word, the worship and fellowship.

To be a "perpetual visitor" to a church is like a man who courts or dates a girl in a non-committal relationship without ever wanting to marry her; and continuing this way through many years of serious relationship. That would be strange and irresponsible to say the least.

May the Lord guide each one of us to do what is right and to God's glory in this
