

"Conduct of the Church" [Eph 4:1-16] Sermon Summary (19 Feb 2023)

1. Manner of Life of the Believer in the Church (vs 1-6)

- walk worthy of your life's calling (vocation). The word "walk" includes our gait and behavior, conduct, demeanour, your entire being in life.
- We belong to someone, Christ and not ourselves. We are defined by who we are in Christ.



- The attributes and disposition of a believer are:

(a) lowliness & meekness

- the thing about pride beware of the big "I" In the middle
- Rom 12:3 "For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith."
- not self-exaltation
- but also, do not unwittingly run down yourself or your family or yourselves when they deserve the credit.
- (b) long-suffering which the opposite is short-tempered
 - a person who suffers without retaliation

(c) forbearing one another in love

- learn to manage your emotions with people from different background
- It is important not to disturb the harmony of the faith of believers
- keep the peace as much as it is possible; be a peacekeeper, not a peace breaker
- unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace

- "one body, one Spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism"
- Rom 12:18-19 "If it be possible, as much as lieth, in you, live peaceably with all men. Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves...Vengeance is mine."

2. Ministry of Gifts of the Believer for the Church (vs 7-11)

- God gives accordingly to His grace according to his will
- everyone is given a measure of gift
- but it may take some time to discover, develop & demonstrate what is that gift given to us by God
- others are blessed by the gift when we exercise it
- "Who is my Master?" is very important.
- He gives different people different gifts to be used for the church. There are different offices like apostles, prophets, pastors, preachers, evangelist, etc. the list is not exhaustive.
- some gifts are temporary like the apostles or prophets and others are permanent like preaching, teaching etc

3. Maturity of the Believers, Building the Church (vs 12-16)

- what is one of the purpose of the church as shared in our 5th anniversary book? It is for the edification of the body of Christ.
- That we will be matured persons unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ in the word of God.
- so that we will not be tossed to & fro with false teachings the body of Christ
- "the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love."

Conclusion

It should be the desire of every Christian to be involved in using our God given gifts and substance and time for the united functioning like the body that make the church an effective witness for Christ to the glory of His name.



SIMPLY GRATEFUL - A Thanksgiving by Bro Poh Huat -

How do I adequately praise God? Simply put, I cannot.

But I do as much as I can. I simply walk the talk. I show up! I present myself personally at the SHBPC Sunday Worship Service. February 26, 2023.

And it was beyond words how wonderful I felt being able to worship our awesome God with the brethren just 5 days out of a



major surgery, out of hospital. "Incredulously incredible!" ..."Wow!"..."Amazing!" The responses rolled out on everyone's tongue marveling at how quickly I had emerged post-surgery.

Just on February 19, 2023, I was the worship leader and after service I said my goodbyes as I psyched up to go into hospital the next day to get operated on my upper spine: my cervical.

Failure to do so would have risked paralysis because of spinal cord compression on 3 cervical points. Surgical entry was through the throat to access the spine. That meant, firstly, a delicate throat incision. Secondly, prying the wound open top-bottom, followed by pushing aside the oesophagus, larynx, and trachea before decompressing the spinal cord and, finally, inserting and securing permanent titanium screws on my affected areas.

Most people balked or cringed each time I described the above procedure. I also risked not waking up from anaesthesia, temporarily losing my voice quality and having swallowing difficulties. Other post-surgery afflictions might follow, such as pain, inside on the spine and at the wound externally. Wound bleeding would also be a challenge.

I was also warned to brace for possible need of blood transfusion and a protracted recovery period if things went south.

I was as ready as I could that Monday morning at 6.30am. Got rolled into the operating theatre with an acid reflux cough that I feared might be possibly disruptive. I was part excited and part quivering.

The words of our victorious LORD Jesus "*I am with you alway* (Matthew 28:20)" kept ringing in my head. I was assured. If He is, He is all I needed.

The operation started and 9 hours later, I woke up, dizzy and nauseous. The effect of the anaesthesia was that my voice was diminished and weak.

Thank you, LORD, I prayed softly, weakly. (1 Thessalonians 5:18 *In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you*) and I faded off to sleep again.

The next morning, my surgeon visited. I woke up, greeted him enthusiastically with a good voice that surprised even me! He marveled at



it. He reported my operation went "very well" and my voice was extraordinarily of good quality. From thereon, progress accelerated, and, by the third day, the physiotherapist had certified me fit to be discharged.

Up until the time of writing this testimony, I had never felt the slightest surgical pains at all which was most bewildering. In a very good way, of course! Our LORD certainly guided the surgeon's hands divinely. It is the least I can explain for the lack of post-surgical trauma.

I asked to stay a couple of extra days, and then I was out of the hospital. "I want to go to church on Sunday!" And our Heavenly Father granted my heart's desire! My surgical episode was veritably demonstrative of God's mercies and grace upon me.

On Monday, February 27, 2023, I visited a regular medical clinic, as instructed by the hospital, to have the stitch on my throat wound removed. The clinic doctor was profoundly impressed, saying the wound had sealed clean, with just one simple stitch, unlike the quintessential "stapled" look. Not the slightest hint of bleeding was seen either.

Then with one simple pull, the single stitch lifted off painlessly. As a bonus, the horizontal incision has also blended with a fold of the neck that will obscure the cut as the skin heals.

I cannot describe it any other way. My God is simply awesome! I praise, exalt, and magnify the Name of our LORD!
