

Be Swift - The Right Perspective -

Singapore is swarmed with a new buzz word as a result of a world class concert (courted by the political leadership at the cabinet level for an economic cause) to boost our economy and we are still recovering from it. The term "Swiftie" is used to describe a dedicated and passionate fan of the renowned singer-songwriter Taylor Swift and has been accepted in the Oxford Dictionary since 2023.



Over the past week, more than 300,000 have flocked swiftly to the National Stadium in Singapore from different countries for 6 days of concert. The fans paid a hefty sum to hear and see their favorite idol gyrating to all her songs and the crowd was mesmerized by her and were cheering throughout with the exchange of friendship bands. The crowd was totally enthralled by her dancing and singing, with diehard fans being mesmerized in mass hysteria shouting in glee, crying and jumping with delight, having memorised and then singing along with her in all her songs which include Fearless, Blank Space, Cruel Summer, Anti Hero, You Belong with Me, Love Story and Is it Over Now, among others.

If only Christians have half the zeal and commitment of these swifties to read and memorise the Word of God in their hearts, how blessed will their souls be!

Biblical Lessons on Being Swift

The Bible does have a **sobering word or two about being swift**, but it may not be what you expect. For example, James warns us here in Jas 1:19, "Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be **swift to hear**, slow to speak, slow to wrath:"

Be the right biblical *swiftie* by having a receptive willing ear to hear (not just Taylor Swift's impressive singing) from the instruction by others and especially the Word of God. Let us also be swift in our velocity to share the gospel of Christ to the saving of souls who are perishing without Christ as their Redeemer.



Being swift is not always a good thing (although it can sometimes be) and we need to humbly submit to the will and Word of God who is sovereign over all. We are reminded by the wise king Solomon of this in Eccl 9:11, "I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favour to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all."

The Apostle Peter warns in 2 Pet 2:1 here, "But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction."

We are also not to do evil or mischief as warned in Rom 3;15 which says, "Their feet are swift to shed blood:", and by King Solomon in Prov 6:18 which says, "A heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief."

We need to be discerning and vigilant of the content we view or the activity we participate in or even the things or people we follow or worship. We are to be prudent and careful as we live in days of spiritual declension and deception as we have seen in recent scams.

Job reminds us soberly of the brevity of life and the nearness of eternity by this counsel in Job 7:6, "My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle, and are spent without hope."

Being Swift to the Gospel Ministry is our privilege and duty. Last Sunday, 3 Mar 2024, 14 of us from SHBPC were at All Saints Home (Poh Huat Road) to share the Gospel and the Word with 27 residents and some nursing staff as arranged by the Chaplains Daniel and Michelle.



DR DON BATTEN received both his B.Sc.Agr. (First Class Honours) and his Ph.D. from the University of Sydney. He worked for 20 years as a research horticulturalist with the NSW Department of Agriculture. His research included environmental adaptation of tropical/subtropical fruits such as mango, lychee and custard apple (Annona), floral biology, floral induction, breeding, environmental physiology (especially water requirements, effects of water deficits), plant taxonomy, and mineral nutrition. His research on floral induction of lychee and mango overturned long-held ideas which had been an impediment to the scientific understanding of these plants, as well as causing economic loss due to inappropriate management of these crops. He conducted a number of research projects that were externally funded, publishing his results in science journals.

Don joined the ministry in Brisbane, Australia in 1994 and has spoken around the world on the creation issue, showing the errors in the evolutionary ideas he was taught. He is co-author of *The Creation Answers Book, One Blood, Answers to the 4 Big Questions, 15 Reasons to Take Genesis as History,* and author of various booklets, including *What about carbon dating?* and *What about arguments for evolution?* Don is one of the three rotating editors of Creation magazine, and has written many articles for Creation as well as the in-depth Journal of Creation. Dr Batten was the CEO and Managing Director of CMI-Australia from 2015 to 2022. He is now Senior Scientist, focusing on research, writing, and speaking.


