"Be Worthy of His Calling" (2Thes 1:1-12) Sermon by Pastor Jack

1. The Church's Testimony vs 1-3

- The mission trip team to Thessalonica comprised Paul, Silas & Timothy and this was part of Paul's second missionary journey.
- In Paul's greeting, note that there is first grace, then peace in this order. For without grace of God, there is no peace. The sequence is important.





2 Thes 1:1-12





- •Are we growing in our faith and love for one another?
- •How can we grow in our faith? Rom 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." It is by the hearing and reading the God's Word. The more you hear, the more you read, the more you study the Word of God is the foundation for growing in faith.
- Note that the tenet of Faith is the Hardware.
 The Software is Charity which is genuine love and concern for others which will cost time & effort, not just in word ie. charity or love in action.

2. The Church's Trials & Tribulations vs 4-7

- vs 4 says, "So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure:"
- Patience and endurance are 2 words frequently used in the Bible; 34 times for "patience" and 96 times for "endure".
- This is especially so for the end-times (eschatology) as mentioned in Luke 21:18-19 "But there shall not an hair of your head perish. In your patience possess ye your souls." Matt 24:13 "But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved." Be mentally prepared if God allows us to suffer for him, whether now of in the future.
- 1Pet 5:9-10 "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world. But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you."



- "after you have suffered a while" so it
 means that there will be suffering in the short run, but God will preserve us
 through it.
- Jas 5:7-8 "Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See
 how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it
 until it receives the early and latter rain. You also be patient. Establish your
 hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand." There is an eschatological
 patience the patience is related to suffering during the end times, if
 necessary, through part of half of the tribulation as God wills and not men.
 See Rom 8:18.



Note that all true faith will be tested and will pass the test, as in Daniel in the lions' den and, Abraham and David and others. When we suffer, let us be patient for the Lord shall deliver us at the right time when we endure to the end

"For a Christian, this is your worst live ever, because your next life is the best life ever in Christ for eternity."

3. The Church's Triumph vs 8-12

- These verses are an apocalyptic imagery of the judgments to come, of the unsaved at the Great White Throne, the saved at the Bema and judgment of the nations.
- v8&9 refers to the judgment of the unsaved. "In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ."
- v10 refers to the saved in Christ who are justified, sanctified, but not yet
 glorified until that day "When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and
 to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you
 was believed) in that day."
- The times will be a difficult and we need to pray for one another.
 "Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power:"
- The grace of God will see us thru
 the trials "That the name of our Lord
 Jesus Christ may be glorified in you,
 and ye in him, according to the
 grace of our God and the Lord
 Jesus Christ." v12

Counting offering after service with three persons as taught in the class and not just one person only and it has to be recorded and signed and countersigned and ready for audit one day if needed.

This is proper church administration and sound financial accountability, and we must fulfil all righteousness in the church of the Lord and do right before God and men for we are answerable before God one day at the judgement seat of Christ.2Cor 5:10

Bible college students have to learn not just preaching but also practical aspects of the ministry too that is equally important in Myanmar and other countries too. Proper responsibility in stewardship is as important as sound preaching in the church and we emphasize that in the Bible college that we teach as we equip the next generation of pastors for different countries by the grace of God.

This was also taught to a group of 25 Vietnamese Pastors some years back under a MMin programme and to a Reformed church in Bangalore, India at a seminar, and we pray for faithful stewardship in our churches and missions today.

Pray for Ps Ai Khun and his family as he preached the gospel and the Word of God and shepherd a flock in Yangon in the midst of unrest and internal conflict. Do uphold the ministries in Yangon with much prayer as we need the Lord "for without him, we can do nothing." (John 15:5)
