# "Wisdom's Guidelines in Triumphant Living" [Prov 3:1-10] Prayer Meeting Devotion Summary (15 Feb 2023)

Pastor welcomed the 15 attendees, comprising a Deacon, members & regular friends and 4 overseas brethren, namely: Pastor Lazarus (Calvary Reformed Church, Bangalore), Elder Habakkuk (Gilead Balm Children's Home, Yangon), Pastor Benjamin (Biblical Reformed Seminary, Yangon) and Sis. Hla Pui (Mercy Church, Nay Pyi Taw).

Pastor shared from Prov 3:1-10. What's "Wisdom Literature"? These include the Books of Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes and Song of Solomon. They were the ancient teaching textbook for the Jewish people; a manual that the Jews use especially for verbal instruction that was very central to traditional Jewish literature and instruction, whereby their Rabbi would quote from when they taught in the synagogue.

The following are the 4 salient points to consider:

## A) Remember the Word of God and His Laws (v1 - 4)

 In Prov 3:1, Solomon, King of Israel, referred to the people close to him as "My Son" and advised, exhorted and challenged the young people NOT to forget (i.e.to REMEMBER) God's law and commandments.



- Forgetfulness is a negative testimony
  of our faith to the unbelievers. Thus we become a less effective
  Christian in this respect. It's also a sign of our indifference and
  ingratitude to God's blessings.
- What's the secret to overcome forgetfulness? Make a concerted, conscious effort to keep God's law and commandments in our heart, which is a safe and reliable place to hide them.
- Why must we remember God's law and commandments? In verse 2, Solomon said, "For length of days and long life and peace shall they add to thee".

- Longevity is dependent on NOT ONLY a balanced diet, proper exercise regime and a healthy lifestyle, but also BLESSINGS and PEACE from God for a compliant heart from us.
- What we need in the final days of our earthly lives will be calmness, serenity and tranquility of our soul, so that we will not be disturbed or fearful
- We must also NOT neglect mercy and truth in our lives, for by doing so, God will grant us His favour and blessings (verse 3)
- God honoured and was faithful to people who were obedient to and who kept His law and commandments eg, Abraham, Job, Daniel and Joseph, because their lives showcased their obedient and compliant heart. (verse 4)

## B) Trust in God with all your heart. (v 5)

- Trust is normally given to someone, something, an organisation, or a righteous God and for the believer is a total reliance on God.
- People generally think highly of themselves and feel that they do not need God or His blessings especially when they are doing well in life.
- This mindset contradicts against the call to trust in God.
- Thus trusting in God will lead to giving up that "trust in the self" mindset, so that they will "lean not on their own understanding", but trust in God instead.
- We can seek understanding of how a thing, a procedure or system works, but we must not depend on that as a basis for our decision or direction in life.
- We are not so "great or omniscient" that we can make an important decision in life without consulting God first.
- When you trust someone, you will want to talk to him and communicate
  with him, especially on major issues in your life. Hence consulting God
  is important as one who is truly seeking the will of God.

# C) Acknowledge God to direct your path. (v 6-8)

- \*The word "acknowledge" has a sense of "to submit, to commit or give in to" with a sense of humility, as you recognise that God is in charge of the situation.
- "Direction" in life is very important to people as any wrong decisions made on all their major life issues may result in sorely dire and negative outcomes upon their lives.



- So the correct order of action is to acknowledge God first and then He will direct and show us which path (way) to take. The word "path" means the correct (proper) way or decision to take.
- When we acknowledge God, we do 3 things:
  - (i) admit that we don't know the way,
  - (ii) seek and ask God for the correct direction and
  - (iii) run away from sin as a result of honouring God.
- A positive outcome is to "fear the Lord and depart from evil". (v. 7)
- A negative outcome is "to be not wise in thine own eyes" (v. 7)
- Verse 8: "It shall be health to thy navel and marrow to thy bones" depicts a picture of spiritual vitality of someone who is so well-guided and protected by God.
- It takes lots of strong discipline to live such a proper and healthy life that is pleasing to God.
- Acknowledging God requires divine help, sustained discipline, great diligence and steady determination to get it right.

### D) Honour God with your Life and Substance. (v 9-10)

- Verse 9: "Honour the Lord with thy substance and with the first fruits of all thine increase."
- The word "substance" refers to material things like food and our tangible or physical assets. Including ourselves as a living sacrifice
- Harvest time is usually around April –
  May, but not all the fruits ripen at the
  same time. Some of them ripen earlier
  than the rest, so these are called
  "first-fruits". They are better in
  appearance and quality, taste
  sweeter and can fetch higher prices



In all your ways acknowledge Him

and He shall direct your paths

PROVERBS 3:6

when sold, so they are considered more valuable and more precious (to their owners) than those that ripen later.

 King Solomon exhorts us to offer our best material possessions to God, to honour Him out of our thankful hearts for His blessings and favour. It is our joy and privilege to give to the Lord joyfully every Sunday for the extension of His kingdom

- When we honour God out of love ,(not for any personal gain)with our time talent and treasure He will honour us too, as He knows and understands our needs, for God is sovereign in His own time and way to bless us, in his own time as he wills as shown in verse 10(even if he does not, we are still joyful to give to the Lord whom we love)
- So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine." (v.10)
- The idea of honouring God is surrendering to God and putting Him first in our lives as it is a honour and our priority to do so to our Savior and Lord. (Mt 6:33). It is a true expression of our devotion to Him and a testimony of our obedience to His Word

### Conclusion

It is a joy and privilege that we can seek God first and submit to his will and to honour God with our material possessions, heart and soul, our time and talents, and even our lives to the glory of God in the extension of His Kingdom. In addition, may we be earnestly motivated to apply the 4 simple yet relevant guidelines from King Solomon for our triumphant daily Christian living.
