

Spurgeon's New Year Resolutions that involved Seeing more than Being

Spurgeon said, "Let me tell you, in a few words, what I see as I look into the new year."



So, what did Spurgeon resolve himself to see? Here are the Preacher's top four resolutions:

1. God's Sovereignty in All Things


"I see a highway cast up by the foreknowledge and predestination of God. Nothing of the future is left to chance; nay, not the falling of a sparrow, nor the losing of a hair is left to haphazard; but all the events of life are arranged and appointed. Not only is every turn in the road marked in the divine map, but every stone on the road, and every drop of morning dew or evening mist that falls upon the grass which grows at the roadside. **We are not to cross a trackless desert; the Lord has ordained our path in his infallible wisdom and infinite love.**"



2. God's Guidance for Us

"I see, next, a Guide provided, as our companion along the way. To him we gladly say, 'Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel.' He is waiting to go with us through every portion of the road.

'The Lord, he it is that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee.' **We are not left to pass through life as though it were a lone wilderness, a place of dragons and owls; for Jesus says, 'I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.'**"



3. God's Strength in Us

"Beside the way and the Guide, I perceive very clearly, by the eye of faith, strength for the journey provided. Throughout the whole distance of the year, we shall find halting-places, where we may rest and take refreshment, and then go on our way singing, "He restoreth my soul." We shall have strength enough, but

none to spare; and that strength will come when it is needed, and not before...God all-sufficient will not fail those who trust him. When we come to the

place for shouldering the burden, we shall reach the place for receiving the strength. If it pleases the Lord to multiply our troubles from one to ten, he will increase our strength in the same proportion....Our lamps shall be trimmed as long as they shall need to burn. **Let not our present weakness tempt us to limit the Holy One of Israel. There is a hospice on every pass over the Alps of life, and a bridge across every river of trial which crosses our way to the Celestial City.** Holy

angels are as numerous to guard us as fallen ones to tempt us. We shall never have a need for which our gracious Father has furnished no supply."

4. God Glorified in our Lives

"One thing more, and this is brightness itself: this year we trust we shall see God glorified by us and in us. **If we realize our chief end, we reach our highest enjoyment. It is the delight of the renewed heart to think that God can get glory out of such poor creatures as we are....**We hope that God has been in some measure glorified in some of us during the past year, but we trust he will be glorified by us far more in the year which now begins....We wish our whole life to be a sacrifice; an altar of incense continually smoking with sweet perfume unto the Most High. Oh, to be borne through the year on the wings of praise to God."



Only God Knows the Future and let us trust Him.

On the morning of January 1, 1892, Spurgeon confessed, "We know nothing of the events which lie before us: of life or death to ourselves or to our friends, or of changes of position, or of sickness or health."

Though Spurgeon did not see much of 1892, he put his trust in the fact that God knows the future. This truth blessed him and made him dependent on God in all things.

Whatever is before us in 2026, let's rest in God's sovereignty, lean fully on God's guidance, rely on God's strength, and live for God's glory. As Spurgeon said, "Throughout this year may the Lord be with you! Amen."

In a few days, 2025 will be history. I believed that many people will be happy to put this 2025 behind them as soon as possible. For me, I want to thank the Lord as 2025 is a year I have gained the most abundant and happiest in my spiritual life in my 65 years living on this earth.

I have been a member of Sovereign Hope BPC for more than a year now. Every Sunday, though listening to Pastor's sermons and teaching from the Sunday school



classes, I can say that what I have learned and growth in the Lord are so much more than what I had from the previous church that I attended for about 20 years. These new gains and knowledge not only gave me a great spiritual renewal, but most importantly, I began to have a strong need and regularity for PRAYing and Bible reading.

Colossians chapter 3

23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.

This passage gave me great guidance. The Lord has given me so much in my spiritual growth, so it is right that I must also give what I can for the Lord, before HE comes again. I attended weekly prayer meetings, Bible reading classes at All Saints Home, and the evening online Chinese worship service, of which, I had been looking forward to for many years.

There are three things I especially want to thank the Lord for His guidance:

1. I have always been resisting to pray openly with a group of people because I am afraid that I will not be able to pray with the correct biblical words or sentences. But after listening to Pastor's sermon and teaching from the Bible, I

understood that when I pray loudly, I am seeking for the support of my brothers and sisters in Christ. My prayers are not to them but to God. Our Heavenly Father will understand what I am saying even though no proper biblical words or sentences are being used. **The more I pray, a closer relationship I will have with the Lord.**

2. One day, when Pastor Jack and Sister Angie assigned me to chair the evening online Chinese worship service, I almost could not find my heart for a long time. I was afraid that I



would not be able to glorify God in selecting hymns and coordinate the discussions. **I began to look to God for guidance. He answered my prayers.** My name is on the roster regularly.



3. After joining the outreach program in helping some elderly residents of All Saints Home in their Bible study, I was assigned to lead the Chinese Bible study class. **With gratitude to the Lord, I began this task and was excited to share God's Words with the selected elderly residents.**

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank Pastor Jack and Sister Angie for their trust and guidance in giving me this opportunity to serve the Lord.

Dear brothers and sisters, **I thank God for giving me many opportunities to serve Him in 2025. I pray that in 2026; He will grant me more opportunities to serve Him before His second coming or He calls me home.**


