"Conditions for God's Blessings" (Deut 28:1-15) Summary of Prayer Meeting Devotion shared by Pastor (18 Jan 2023)



Pastor Jack welcomed the 13 attendees (regular members & friends and especially Preacher Mok Chee Cheong and Carol from New Life BPC, London) and brethren from Myanmar and India.

We opened the Prayer Meeting with the hymn, "Count Your Blessings" which encourages us to be grateful and thankful to God.

Thereafter, Pastor Jack led us in Opening Prayer. Next, we took turns to read God's Word from Deut 28:1-15 before Pastor Jack expounded on it.

3 Salient Points to consider as Conditions for Blessings

(I) Know and Obey the Word of God (v1)

- a) Everyone wants blessings. It is only natural, but it is conditional.
- b) But real lasting blessings rightly come from only God who give blessings.
- c) God set the standard (of obedience) to ALL that we are to know and keep His commandments.
- d) We cannot choose whichever blessing we want to observe/obey.
- e) We must first Seek to Know, then Hearken/Hear God and Do it. This is the secret: to hearken & to put it into practice. (Ignorance is not bliss.)
- f) Blessings can also come in the form of spiritual blessings besides the physical ones like peace, comfort, joy, hope and good health.
 - fruit of the body (childbirth)
 - fruit of the ground (harvest from agriculture)
 - fruit of the cattle (more young's, milk & meat produced)
 - safety in travelling (Psalm 121: Blessing in your travel in your going out & coming in)
 - The Lord's blessings for victory over your enemies (v7)

• It is fine to look for "blessings'/peace. Peace is with God first, then we will get the peace of God and we can also ask God to protect & bless the family with His grace and mercy.

(II) Be Holy and Walk in God's Ways (v9)

- a. Be holy means to be set apart for God (separated/consecrated/set apart for God) and God will bless you of you put Him first.
- b. "Walk in God's way" suggests doing it every day with a willingness to conform, seek out God's will & submit to God and His will and not to self or the world.
- c. As a Christian, do you think it is right to do things contrary to God's commandments & still expect to be blessed? God has certain principles that govern our life, our work, our thoughts, behaviour, our deeds that are sound and edifying and we need to find out and obey and live it out too.

(III) Serve the Lord with Joyfulness of Heart Willingly (v47)

- vs 47 reads: Because thou servedst not the LORD thy God with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things.
- b. The idea of serving God has 2 elements.
 - One is worshipping God and that is the most important when we spend time with God in worship in his sanctuary first and the other is doing something to please / glorify God. For example, we must first come to seek and worship God and then the work of ushering visitors, evangelism / outreach ministry, conducting Sunday School and other ministry of the church like NBC or SS Classes, chairing the worship service, playing on the piano...outreach, prayer etc.
 - Serving God is a privilege and a sacred duty and done with the right spirit. Blessing is conditional and we must do it God s way.
- c. If we serve / worship God with joyfulness & willingness, God will give His blessings as He wills.

Conclusion

So, how can we be blessed and better worship and serve God in the new year? Let this be our challenge to be more fervent and fruitful and faithful in our lives for Christ and be a good witness as a truly-born again child of God. Nothing is too insignificant to be used by God for His glory and be a faithful steward for the Lord.

When we begin to embrace our true identity in Christ, then there will be a fulfilment and effective and victorious Christian living in us and our families and our churches.


