



# "Understanding Christ & The Sanctuary of God" (Heb 8:1-13)

- Sermon Summary -

## 1. Superior Sanctuary in the Heaven (vs 1-2)


- The author began by saying that "this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;" signifying that we have a superior high priest in Christ.



- It further referred to a true tabernacle "which the Lord pitched, and not man."
- He is not an earthly priest, neither an earthly tabernacle.
- This contrasts with Heb 9:1 which referred to *"a worldly sanctuary"* which was an earthly tabernacle.
- Heb 9:8 further explained that the earthly tabernacle was a foreshadowing of Christ, the high priest & the heavenly tabernacle which was to come.
- Heb 9:23-24 "It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in



the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us."


- The superior sanctuary is in heaven and there is no physical temple, no sun, no moon as John said in Rev 21, because Christ Himself is the temple & the light.
- Application: a church does not need to have a big physical church building, but rather any place where the elect of God gathers for worship that is set apart for the Lord (eg. Many churches like SHBPC worship in a place located in an industrial building.)

#### 2. Sacred Sacrifice in Christ the Mediator (vs 3-6)

- Heb 8:6 "But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises."
- It is a Comparative ie. it is better than the old one in the Old Testament.
- The superiority of the new covenant lies in Christ.
- The old covenant is not faulty by itself, but the people had failed to keep the old covenant.
- Heb 7:22-28 "By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better testament. And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered to continue by reason of death: But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then

for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself. For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, maketh the Son, who is consecrated for evermore."

- Christ Himself was the sacrifice (not sheep or goat as sacrifice), He offered Himself once and for all as a sacrifice for His people on the cross and that is sufficient.
- Heb 9:11-14 "But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with



hands, that is to say, not of this building; Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth




to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"

 Note that it is the power of Christ in what He did for us that is the basis of our transformation and our coming to Him in worship and our profession of faith.

## 3. Special Security in the New Covenant (vs 7-13)

 Jer 31:31-34 "Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD:



for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more. with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, Land write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

- The new covenant is a unilateral covenant by God alone.
- 1 party decided everything & the other obtained all the benefits monogeistic.
- It is new in term of quality, not time ie the Greek word here is "*kairos*" and not "*chronos*".
- It is focused on the spiritual, not the physical
- Heb 8:10 "I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people."
- Their lives will be changed from within their hearts and mind changed not just externally and they will be blessed eternally In the Lord if they trust in Christ and not self or works ow the law. It is the basis of hope and peace and life forever more.
- Heb 8:11 has a condition that one must "Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest."

#### Conclusion

With Christ as the mediator of the New Covenant, we who believe in Him as our Savour are partakers the benefits of this New Covenant even the Gentiles today.


