- Fulfilling our Calling
in the Church -**

We come with grateful hearts today to offer praise and thanksgiving to God for His covenant faithfulness to SHBPC these 6 fruitful years. **We praise God for we have witnessed His covenant goodness to us all these years of productive ministry and growth and mission outreaches and the building up of the congregation.** We who are saved by sovereign grace are called to be stewards and to walk worthy of the Lord in our vocation (Eph 4:1). We are to learn from the good examples in the Old Testament. God has blessed and prospered us these 6 years in SHBPC with growth in our ministry and missions. We are to do the same as we emulate other worthy examples and fare well in our ministry as good witnesses and testimonies for our Lord Jesus Christ.

On this special 6th anniversary, we will look at six metaphors (among others) to depict and describe the Christian life that we should strive to live as follows:

1. Faithful Stewards of the Gifts of God

The world emphasizes ownership, but the Bible says that we are not owners but called to be custodians, managers or trustees of the manifold grace of God as there is accountability to our God one day (Rom 14:12). As members of SHBPC, we are to be responsible for the work which is entrusted to us and manage it well to glorify our Master.





Note 1 Pet 4:10, 11 which says, "As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen." Everyone has at least one gift and we ought to be using it for the glory of God and to edify others and not ourselves (Rom 12:6-8).

Paul in 1 Cor 4:2 says, "Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful." There is a requirement for all stewards to be faithful in using our God given time and treasure to extend his kingdom for we are accountable to God one day.

Our Lord has given us a vision to have our own worship place in due time as our present premises is rented and the rent has increased last year. God the Lord has blessed us with much both spiritually and materially. **Each one of us has different talents and monetary resources as He wills. We are not to hoard our talents or substance but to give of ourselves and our time and substance to God as good and faithful stewards and to the blessing of others and the growth and ministry of the church.** We are all accountable to God at the bema or the judgement seat of Christ one day for how we serve and use God given resources (2 Cor 5:10). He will bless and reward those for their faithfulness to Him one day (Matt 25:15-30). Let us pray to serve and give to the Lord faithfully in supporting and building up the local church to the edifying of the saints and the saving of souls. (2Cor 9:7)

2. Alert Soldiers of Christ in the Battlefield

2 Tim 2:2-4, "And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier." We have



National Service in Singapore, and all able-bodied young men have to do about 2 years of tough training and then a military vocation during which time they are constantly to be ready and alert. The Israelis have one of the best armies in the world and our National Service in Singapore learnt from them.

As Christians, we are all conscripted in the Lord's army and our church is a spiritual force to be reckoned with. We are all in a spiritual warfare zone and there is an enemy waiting to devour us if possible, but we are not to be intimidated (1 Pet 5:8). We need to be alert, disciplined soldiers and be readily equipped with the full armour of God (Eph 6:10-18). **Be vigilant to potential dangers in a fallen world**

that we live in and do not be entangled with the affairs of the world but look to please only our Commander, our Lord Jesus Christ. Are you equipped and ready to share the gospel and defend the faith as a church today as the Lord calls?

3. Fit Athletes in the Race of Life

Heb 12:1, 2 says, *"Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,*

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." The recent Olympic Games witnessed the good performance of some of our sportsmen who won medals after they trained hard, bringing glory to the nation.



Singapore is facing a greying population as we age and we need wisdom to end well in life. We are all involved in a long race of life and we are to keep spiritually fit and healthy and run carefully, keeping to the rules that are set for us with perseverance and endurance, looking up to Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith (Heb 12:1, 2). Christian athletes are not to disqualify ourselves by going against the regulations set for us by God (1 Cor 9:24-27). There is to be no doping or cheating in the race of life or cutting corners to win unlawfully. **Let us as faithful stewards of Christ trust and obey God, keeping to the rules and running patiently to win the eternal prize and bring glory to God and end well by His grace (Phil 3:13, 14).**

4. Diligent Farmers in the Harvest Fields



Israel was largely an agrarian economy in the first century and sowing and reaping are common economic activity then. Over these 6 years, our church has been sowing the gospel seed in the vicinity of our church these few years. 1 Cor 3:7-10, *"So then neither is he that planteth anything, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour. For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon."* We are to be diligent not indolent. Be patient in sowing and watering and also reaping with spiritual fruits in due time as our labour for the Lord is not in vain even (1 Cor 15:58) while working in the harvest field. It is a great joy to see the fruits of our mission as souls are saved by the grace of God.

Last year, SHBPC sent out mission teams to teach and minister in the Bible colleges and children home in Myanmar, to share the Word at the 3 churches in

Bangalore and Hyderabad, India and to preach in Filadelfia BPC in Batam. We will continue to support missions in India, Myanmar Batam and preachers in country X. We have an evening Chinese fellowship ministry on Sunday night that ministers to Chinese believers both locally and abroad **Remember we reap what we sow (Gal 6:7-10). Farmers are industrious and faithful workers. Let us do our part in fulfilling the Great Commission and sow the Gospel seed for the Lord in the wide harvest fields in His vineyard, wherever the Lord puts us.**

5. Unattached Pilgrims and Strangers in a Fleeting World

1 Pet 2:11, 12, *"Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation"* and Heb 11:13-16, *"These all died in faith, not*



having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country. And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned. But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city." Do not drive your stakes too deep for tomorrow we may break camp.

We do not belong here as this is an ephemeral world and we are just passing through. This was John Bunyan's favorite analogy in his much-celebrated allegorical work, *Pilgrim's Progress*, in the 17th century. Pilgrims have a religious objective to seek God. We are depicted not as long-term citizens of a fallen world or permanent residents but temporal travelers on the earth amidst dangers and trials in our pilgrimage (i.e. Slough of Despond, Apollyon, Castle of Fear, etc.), yearning forward to the imminent coming of our Lord and the celestial city one day. While a vagabond has no home, a fugitive is running away from home, a pilgrim is on his way home. Let us all in 2024 and beyond, to live with this mindset while we worship and serve God in SHBPC and to set our affections on things above and not on the earth (Col 3:1).

6. Able Ambassadors of Heaven on Earth

Ambassadors play an important role in building good relations among countries. 2 Cor 5:20 says, *"Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God."* It is a great honour to be an ambassador of a country (Eph 6:20). We represent our heavenly country, where our Lord Jesus is King. Let us be worthy and honourable envoys of Christ while we are in a foreign land. Our thoughts, actions and speech are to be honourable and compatible with our high



calling. We are to be light and salt in this world to bring others to the knowledge of Christ. Let our testimony and actions be exemplary as we are to be effective and exemplary diplomats for our Lord.

Conclusion

Our 6th anniversary is special as God gives us a vision and burden, to purchase and have our own worship place in due season as the Lord enables us. As Christians, we are called to be spiritual ambassadors, soldiers, athletes, farmers, pilgrims and strangers on the earth. We are to be good witnesses and stewards for Christ's sake and to pray and support the work of the gospel in SHBPC. That means that our Christian purpose and duty on earth is earthly gains or economic achievements in this temporal world, but we invest in eternity and set our affections above.

In the years ahead, SHBPC is committed to serve God in fervent prayer life and regular Sunday worship, evangelism and faithful service of the most High God is priority and not to be neglected. There is much to be done for God while we have yet breath. We are to be reliable and responsible stewards and ambassadors for Christ in SHBPC to honour and serve Him first on earth wherever he puts us. **We represent the Almighty Jehovah, the King of kings and the Lord of lords and that is a grave duty and prerogative to be discharged fearfully by the members and worshippers of SHBPC till He comes.**

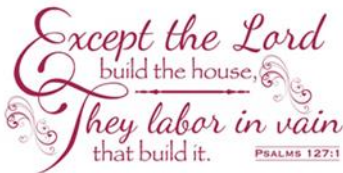
