The construction will be started in February hopefully as we approach the government right now.

A Testimony of God's Sovereign Grace

Watchnight Service 31 Dec 2025

Beloved brethren in the Lord,

Grace, mercy, and peace be unto you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

As we gather on this Watchnight—closing one year and standing at the threshold of another—I give thanks unto God, not for human strength nor human resolve, but for His sovereign grace toward a sinner such as I.

My life's journey has taken me from one island to another—from Penang to Singapore. Yet the greater journey has been spiritual: **from fear unto peace, from darkness unto light, and from self-rule unto submission under the lordship of Jesus Christ.**

I was raised in a household that outwardly identified as Buddhist, but in practice was deeply shaped by Taoist beliefs and rituals. Fear of the unseen governed our lives—fear that demanded appeasement, fear that offered no assurance, and fear that never granted rest.

The Scriptures declare:

"The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe." Prov 29:25

During my childhood years through the 80's and the 90's, safety and peace were unknown to us. In the year 1991, our family encountered a severe trial. My mother, who was a nursing-sister, was diagnosed with breast cancer. Cancer is not only an affliction of the body; it is a heavy burden upon the soul of a family. Subsequent to surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation treatment, we hoped the suffering had ended. Yet the disease returned, morphed into a different manifestation—as chronic myelogenous leukaemia.

In her desperation, every belief system was explored. Every promise of relief was considered. Gnosticism turned, and syncretism entered unavoidably. Yet peace remained beyond our grasp.

How true are the words of our Lord:

"Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you." John 14:27

The irrefutable fact was, the peace we sought could not be found in the world.

In later years, I entered academic management and counselling. Outwardly, my life appeared ordered and productive. Ironically, i was guiding others through difficulty. Yet inwardly, my own heart remained restless and unsettled.



Then, in God's quiet Providence, i encountered something most ordinary—a diary containing Scripture verses at the top of its pages, without its Bible references, offered merely as encouragement.

Soon after, I mustered courage and did obtain my first Bible through a friend with whom tears and laughter were shared. I began reading the New Testament. And as I read, I came to a clear and sober conviction: this was not myth, nor legend, nor moral philosophy. This was truth. This was history. This was the living Word of God—still is and forever shall be. Q4 of 2006 brought me to my knees—no longer to gods of unknown origins, but to the one and only Sovereign Lord God of the universe. I do not remember the exact date, but things I used to revere, I ran away from.

The Scripture testifies:

"For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword."
Hebrews 4:12

Through that Word, God confronted the deepest error of my life—that my life belonged to myself. I came to understand that I was never my own. i belong—body and soul—to the Lord Jesus Christ, who is not merely Saviour, but Lord.

As the Apostle Paul declares:

"For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's." Cor 6:20

The peace i sought through fear-driven rituals, human knowledge, and personal achievement was never meant to be found there. True rest was given only when God, by His grace, brought me to submit to Christ and to trust wholly in His finished work. My baptism was on 23 Dec 2007. My mother cried for more than a week as though she had lost her son. She did. I was no longer the old me, but Christ who lives in me. My sanctification shall be until my final breath or until the Parousia.

Our Lord Himself calls,

"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." Matt 11:28

Beloved brethren, I stand before you tonight not as one who has attained, but as one who has been redeemed. Not as one who sought God by his own wisdom, but as one whom God sought and saved by grace alone.

With the prophet Jonah, I confess: *"Salvation is of the LORD."* Jon 2:9

To God alone be the glory—for His sovereign mercy, His unfailing patience, and His grace toward my soul, now and unto eternity.
