




Fitness in Fearless Fighting



Alertness and Affection


Laughs and Loving Actions

Christian (1 Pet 4:7 - 11)

Mdm Chew Tai Yin shared her testimony on the bountiful blessings from God during the Circuit Breaker period. Hymns of Praises were sung in Chinese before the message was presented to us.



Salient points of the message were:

- A) Verse 7 - A Christian must be vigilant and sober, alert at all times. 1 Thessalonians 5: 6 - 7 says, "*Therefore let us not sleep, as do others, but let us watch and be sober. For they that sleep, sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.*" There are two enemies which we must be wary of. Our greatest enemy is none other than ourselves! Satan and the world is the other and we need to be careful.
- B) End of verse 7... "*watch unto prayer*".
It is the duty of every Christian to pray fervently for - self, family, church, nation and others - to bring honour and glory to God, according to God's will and perfect timing. Do we knee often to seek God in intercession with thanks giving like Daniel?
- C) Verses 8 & 9 - To adopt and exhibit the true spirit of Christian love by our actions. Charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Don't complain, murmur, grumble, or bear a grudge against another . . . Reach out to others in genuine affection and allow yourself to be used by God to be a blessing unto others. Is there someone who needs help from you today?
- D) Verses 10 & 11 - Every Christian has a spiritual gift (gifts) from God at the point of regeneration. We are to discover, develop and exercise this gift (gifts) with our time, talents or our treasure in an acceptable manner towards God. In 1 Corinthians 4: 1 & 2, we are all stewards not owners and we are to be faithful, reliable and dependable stewards of our God given gifts to highlight the manifold grace of God to whom we are accountable to one day. Use your time and your energy and your God given resources in humble service and tithes and offerings to extend the kingdom of God for his glory. Be faithful in your dutiful service in God's kingdom and it is a joy to serve the Lord for he is coming soon.
