"The Warning & Work of Christ (Heb 2:1-18)

- Summary of the sermon by Pastor on 14 Jan 2024 -

This is the second message in the Jan-Mar 2024 sermon series on "*The Majesty & Supremacy of the Son of God* (*Book of Hebrews*)". The author of Hebrew continues with another sobering message for us.

1. Warning of Spiritual Neglect (vs 1-4)

- The chapter begins with "*Therefore*" and hence it is related to the preceding chapter.
- "we ought to give the <u>more earnest heed</u> to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them <u>slip</u>." We have to pay attention and take heed.
- The word "*slip*" means that Christians tend to drift away from God. There are worldly things that enthral and take us away from our focus on God.
- Prov 14:14 "The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways: and a good man shall be satisfied from himself." A sign of backsliding is when one




"Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life." Proverbs 423 (KJV) wants to do things their own way and is selfcentred. In contrast, a good (godly) man finds contentment from outside of himself i.e. in God.

- The starting point for the backslider is the condition of the heart. Solomon in Prov 4:23 says, "Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it are the issues of life."
- An example in the New Testament was Demas. 2 Tim 4:10 "For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica;



Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia." Demas was a co-labourer with Paul, but he loved the present world and later deserted Paul and the ministry.


- 1 John 2:15-16 "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world."
- There are some who may fall away for a short season, but if truly saved will return and be brought back to the Lord. E.g. John Mark was not doing well initially and was rejected by Paul in the ministry, but later Paul asked for him. Those who never come back to the Lord are not truly saved.
- Heb 2:3 "How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation ... "
- How can we escape from the wrath of God, the eternal condemnation of sinners? We cannot blame God if we are negligent and disregard God and His Word.
- Luke 16:16 says "The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and <u>every man presseth</u> <u>into it</u>."
- It is a very proactive pressing into the kingdom of God which is our duty.
- God elects us unto salvation, but God also expects us not to neglect our duty and responsibility to seek Him too.



- Consider what the Lord said of Judas in Mark 14:21 - "The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him: but woe to that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! good were it for that man if he had never been born."
- Judas was fully culpable for his own action and he cannot blame God. God did not fix him up. Judas decided for himself to betray God for 30 pieces of silver.
- The Bible said that God hardened Pharaoh's heart, but it also said that Pharaoh hardened his own heart (see Exo 7:3, 8:32).
- We cannot blame it on God's election if we are not saved, for we are responsible for our own condemnation.

2. Wonder of the Death of Christ (vs 9-13)


- "But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man." Heb 2:9. Is this a so-called contradiction as earlier in Heb 1:4 it is mentioned Christ is higher than the angels?
- No, it is not a contradiction at all. Heb 2:9 is referring to Christ in the context of His Humanity. In that sense, in His human form, He was considered lower than angels but Heb 1:4 is referring to His Deity.



- Death is the cessation of life. The zenith of Christianity is the death of its Founder. The Death of Christ spells Life for His followers.
- The death of Christ is what John Owen the famous Puritan said was "*The Death of Death*."
- We glory in the cross and we are not ashamed of it for it gives us life.
- it a glorious mystery of the Cross where Jesus died for us. We can tell others of this glorious message of His death, and that He rose 3 days later, victorious over the grave.
- Satan has a temporal power, the power of death. "And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." Heb 2:15
- But Christ came to destroy death by His Death on the Cross.
- One "S" in the **S**uffering of Christ for us has an important impact. It resulted in three "S's" our **S**alvation, **S**anctification & the **S**ecurity of our souls.

3. Work of the Merciful & Faithful High Priest (vs 14-18)

- Heb 2:17 "Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a <u>merciful and</u> <u>faithful high priest</u> in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people."
- Jesus is the Only One who is able to perform all 3 roles: *Prophet* (representing God to God), *Priest* (representing Man to God) and *King*.



- 2 important adjectives: Merciful (compassion & kindness) & Faithful
- He Is merciful no one can say that Jesus does not understand what we are going thru in life.
- He is faithful, in contrast with human high priest such as Eli who was unfaithful.

Conclusion

Praise God for our Lord Jesus for We have a Great Savior and a Caring God. We need follow Christ and to be faithful and merciful in our stewardship and to be like our Lord in the New Year.
