## "8 Vital Thoughts for CNY 2024"

The Chinese people gives great attention to the celebration of the Chinese New Year (CNY) with the family in reunion dinners, delectable and sumptuous food, and enjoyment of various forms. It is good that we also consider things that are relevant to us as Christians as we do or enjoy these things. As we celebrate CNY with our family and friends this week, let us be mindful of the following thoughts as a Christian who is saved by the blood of Christ.



### 1. Cherish & Relish your God & Loved Ones in the New Year.



Do not take God and your significant others especially our seniors for granted for there will come a time when they will not be around. Seek first the kingdom of God and He will add all the things we need to our lives. (Matt 6:33) Acts of love should not be delayed for we do not know when the opportunity will be over one day.

Live life with no regrets and love your God with all your heart and mind and soul.

Show genuine love and kindness to others as God gives you the opportunity for we have a short journey of life together on earth and let us number our days and apply our hearts unto wisdom. (Psa 90:12)

### 2. Communicate with God & Others Soundly and Truthfully

Prayer is the breath of godliness and our lifeline to heaven. (Heb 4:16) Spend much time in intercession and supplication this New Year for it is the source of your strength. We share every day through WhatsApp, social media platforms with both non-verbal and oral communication and written emails in our interpersonal relationships. Your words can hurt or heal a person and be careful

### 4. Study, Meditate & Embrace the Promises of God.



Our God is the same yesterday, today and forever. We live in a world of constant change and the unpredictable is real. Christian can embrace the unknown for we have a God who holds tomorrow as the hymn writer says, and He holds my hands. We can adapt to unforeseen circumstances because He is sovereign and is still on the throne no matter what happens and trust in the reliable promises of God found in His inspired Word. Read and

relish the inspired Word of God and seek to practice and apply it to your life as He enables you.

## 5. Seek Contentment in God & Not Covetousness in Ephemeral Things.

The love of money or practical greed is the root of all evil as Paul correctly warned. (1Tim 6:10) Learn to be thankful to God and be content with godliness and not murmur nor complain. The Chinese love to gamble (buy 4-D or Toto to strive to be rich) and play mahjong during CNY. A Christian must not be involved in these. Instead, we should be content and to appreciate the people that God has given

us in our everyday life by cherishing the simple pleasures of life like eating, time with family and friends, worshipping God and find fulfilment and lasting contentment in the Lord and not in material things or worldly pleasure. Do not let avarice undermine or destroy your testimony or life this year.

## 6. Understand that the Lord is Coming Soon & there is Accountability to Him.

Christians have a glorious hope in the future because Christ is coming again to rule and judge the world. We have a unique opportunity to worship and serve God or self or man in this life and we need to make the right decisions whom we serve, for it affects our present life and eternal destiny. We have a God who is seated in the heaven ruling over all in His Providence.

Rather than the question of "Who am I?", a question often asked by young people, we should instead ask "Whose am I?" Whom do I belong to ultimately? That will define your life, your goals, and your future too when you know who is in charge of you. Do you belong to God and is under His guidance or rule or do you do what is right in your own eyes? Something to pray and ponder this CNY.

# 7. Be an Active Part of a Witnessing, Working and Worshipping Christian community in the Church.

The Chinese people is a closely knit community in the villages and CNY is a time for reunion and the rebuilding of relationships. Be committed to the local church and serve and grow and get involved in the ministry of the Lord. We are all spiritual



and social beings, and we seek meaningful relationships and fellowship and a sense of belonging in a community. Through the avenue of the gathered church every Lord's Day In corporate worship, we find growth, consolation and support, in a Christian network of the church in lasting caring profound meaningful relationships among the people of God. (Heb 10:24,25) **Do not be a passive or uncommitted Christian this year but one that is zealous for the Lord fervent in spirit serving Him as an individual or couple or family.** 

### 8. Live Life with an Eternal Purpose & Intent in Mind.

The heart and the mind are important centres of our live and we need to discipline our thoughts and intents of our hearts. As we read the obituary in the newspapers (the passing away of a famous Chinese tycoon in Singapore), we are reminded again that life is fleeting and ebbing away every day. By soberly knowing the brevity of life and the nearness of eternity, let us live life with purposeful goals and aims that will have a lasting value.

Give up selfish worldly dreams of being rich and famous, and worldly gain and temporal assets. Instead, let God lead you to live a meaningful humble but fulfilling life filled with spiritual meaning and lasting fulfilment as we worship and serve Him with our time, talent and treasure. Let us be prepared to meet our God one day. (Amos 4:12)

With the help of the Holy Spirit who indwells within us, let us unpack and repack our lives in 2024 in the will of God for the journey is temporal.

In running the race of life, do not bring unnecessary baggage and worldly luggage which ought not to be there but press on forward with sound godly prudence in the wisdom of God and spirited resilience. Let us learn from the legendary Chinese doll, the 不倒翁 bu dao weng with its resilience despite all difficulty and possible challenges.

Let us keep on keeping on for Christ's sake in the New Year for His glory.
